July 2024 NORTH CAROLINA BAR EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must comply with the following requirements for the July 2024 North Carolina Bar Examination:

I. Applicants are not permitted to handwrite the Multistate Essay Examination (MEE) and Multistate Performance Test (MPT) components of the North Carolina Bar Examination. Unless granted a testing accommodation due to a disability under the Americans with Disabilities Act, applicants must take the MPT and MEE portions of the examination using their personal laptop computers and ExamSoft Examplify[®] secure software.

Laptop registration for the July 2024 North Carolina Bar Examination opened at 12:00 pm. Eastern Time on May 21, 2024. It closes at 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on June 14, 2024.

<u>Applicants must pay the \$125 administrative fee and complete the laptop registration</u> <u>process by 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on June 14, 2024</u>. Please note that the laptop fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Prior to registration opening, ExamSoft will email all applicants an ID and password to download and install Examplify[®]. The registration information will come from <u>noreply@examsoft.com</u>. Applicants should mail the registration payment to the North Carolina Board of Law Examiners with the Laptop Application. The laptop application can be found in the 'Laptop Use' section on the home page of the Board's website, <u>www.ncble.org</u>. <u>Registration needs to be completed and payment needs to be received by the Board</u> <u>of Law Examiners no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 14, 2024</u>. This is a receipt deadline, not a postmark deadline.
